Meeting called to order at 4:30 PM by John Mitby

Approval of minutes of previous meetings:

Moved by Massie to approve the minutes of the Board meeting of February 22, 2018 meeting. Second by Maly. MC 2 – 0.

District No. 4:

Board has approved payment of \$8,257.61 to Kartechner Bros. Need a cap on the vent pipe on Mueller Road.

District No 7:

Hugh Anderson questioned the need for the assessment for cost. Have bids to replace a bridge on the Zeigler field road with a culvert (approximately \$15,000). Have spent roughly \$2,000 for engineering services to prepare plans and specs.

District No. 8:

Petition by Paul Stang and Alyssa L. Gosbee Stang to remove parcel (0811-311-9500-2) from District 8 and waive the assessment of cost (\$1070.40). Moved by Massie to approve the petition. Second by Maly. MC 2 – 0.

Landowners are installing drain tile in the upland soils and connecting them to the main ditch. Names will be provided to the Board so they can inspect the situations.

District No. 16:

Jarrod Wileman (BLT AG) advised the Board that their lands do not have access to an outlet drain to the main ditch in District 16. He has provided an estimate from JKS Excavating to provide a tile line which includes 1,400 feet of 12-inch tile across the Anderson Family Trust lands (\$9,800) and 600 feet of 12-inch tile into the D. & F.

Wileman lands (\$4,200), and two vents (\$1,000) for a total of \$15,000. The estimate also notes that the cost actually could be up to \$20,000.

Massie moved that Board approve installing the tile line at District No. 16 expense. Second by Maly. MC 2 – 0.

Doug Wileman has petitioned the Drainage Board to

- 1) Designate the private tile line (drain) from the Howard and Floyd Wileman Farms, Inc. lands (SE 1/4 of the NE ¼ of Section 30, T-05N, R-12E) northwest across Hammond Road and the northeast corner of the Anderson Family Trust lands to the east end of Lateral A - 2 in Dane County Drainage District 16 as a district tile lateral to insure that the Wileman lands can continue to achieve the drainage benefits assigned to their lands.
- 2) Designate the private tile line (drain) extending east from the end of Lateral A – 4 across Anderson Family Trust lands (NE ¼ of the NE ¼, Section 30, T-05N, R-12E) to the former Gary Thalacher lands (NW1/4 of the NW1/4, Section 29, T-05N, R-12E) as a district tile lateral to insure the now D. & F. Wileman lands can continue to achieve the drainage benefits assigned to their lands.

Massie moved to approve the petition and to replace the plugged tile line across the Anderson lands to lateral A – 4. Second by Maly. MC 2 – 0.

District No. 21:

A beaver dam has been removed.

District No. 28:

Keith Reamer reports that there is a problem west of Oak Park Road. Paul Maly will investigate the situation for the Board.

Tom Zickert on Oak Park Road may have a problem. Paul Maly will investigate the situation for the Board.

Moved by Massie to adjourn the meeting. Second by Maly. MC 3 – 0. Meeting adjourned at 6:00 PM.
