- 6. Approve and finalize any area of any of the districts where 20-foot corridor needs to be increased to 100 feet.
- 7. Districts 8/9:
 - a. Status of Creek Haven project;
 - b. Status of contractor's offer to do work on District #8;
 - c. Report from engineer as to work to be done in District #8;
 - d. Discuss doing work in stages and prioritize; and

- e. Need to request bids for project.
- 8. Sun Prairie and Sun Prairie treatment plant:
 - a. Assessment proposed to Sun Prairie for treatment plant use (of the 9,700 acre drainage area in District 9, roughly 5,621 acres are in City of Sun Prairie); and
 - b. Need drainage areas and District 8 boundaries to estimate work, time and assessment

At the conclusion of any hearing on assessments, the district board will determine the amount of any levy or assessment, when such assessment is due and payable, interest rate to be charged after the assessment due date, and the lands or owners thereof that are to be assessed benefits in accordance with Chapter 88 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

The district board may also decide whether to borrow money based upon any assessment levied, to award any contract for part or all of the work, and to award or approve any contract for engineering or other professional fees.

The Board may also establish a fund for the payment of costs of maintenance and repair and levy an additional assessment in an equitable manner under Section 88.23, Wis. Stats.

All objections to the jurisdiction of the drainage board, or to the sufficiency or legality of any petition, report, or assessment, or to the equity of meeting and/or any assessment or award of damages shall be filed with the drainage board in writing before the hearing; such objections shall be set forth clearly and in detail.

This meeting/hearing is pursuant to sections 88.05 and 88.23(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes and ATCP 48.02(1), 48.22, and 48.24 Wis. Administrative Code.
