Re: Work in District #29: Flooding Issues/Water (Norway Grove School Road)

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is to inform you that the Dane Co. Drainage Board inspected District 29 this past spring and found flooding, cleanout of channel, bank damage and need for sediment removal. It is the opinion of the Board that a meeting is necessary to determine the assessment responsibility for work that needs to be done. An early estimate of the damage is \$12,000-\$14,000.

We will hold a Zoom meeting as part of the Drainage District's annual meeting this fall (maybe before) and, at that time, will review the findings and may make a clean out assessment due to water contribution to the District from any party inside or outside the district. We would like members of the district, the Town and Madison Sand and Gravel to be a part of this Zoom meeting. You all will receive Notice of such meeting at a later date. The District will discuss work needed and may order Madison Sand and Gravel and the Town of Vienna to submit necessary plans and specifications required by Wis. Stat. § 88.92 to the District. The District may also request authorization for the connection and discuss other connections. There may be assessments for work if so required if using part or all of the drainage district's channel.
