A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) has been developed between the Drainage Board and City of Sun Prairie. Approvals by the City and Board are in progress.

6. A review and inspection of the district found the following:

Plans are to remove trees and brush in the drainage corridor and fallen trees in the main ditch full length of the District. The main drain needs to be cleaned out for much of the total length.
