## ANNUAL REPORT

## As of August 31, 2017

The Dane County Drainage Board submits the following annual report for the above identified drainage district for the twelve (12) month period ending August 31, 2017.

- 1. No work done in the district.
- 2. A review and inspection of the district found the following:

There is a large tree lying cross the ditch bt the Village park and St. Francis Street.

The ditch crossing north of Cross Plains at County trunk Highway P has three large culverts. Only one has flow going through it. Brush is growing on the north side of the ditch.

At the first driveway north of the Village (Fire No. 5054), there was good flow. Trees and brush are starting to grow both north and south of the driveway along the ditch.

Land between driveway and Enchanted Road - There is a buffer strip on both sides of the ditch with trees/brush growing in the strips.

There was a good flow at Enchanted Valley Road. There are some trees along the ditch to the north of Enchanted Valley Road. There is a buffer (?) strip along both sides of the ditch south of Enchanted Valley Road.

At the next road north of Enchanted Valley Road (dead end drive), the land to the north is wooded. There is brush at the culvert. The ditch to the south was grass-filled, flow was going through.

Trees are now growing on both banks south of County Trunk Highway K; there was flow to the south.

The bridge crossing on Ziegler's land needs to be replaces. Currently working with Resource Engineering Associates to get the permits to replace the bridge with a low profile culvert. Preliminary estimate is roughly \$15.000.
